  - Operate primarily across Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, South Dakota and/or Wisconsin
  - Offer economically viable and/or previously tested products or services in one of the following categories: food and beverage; product innovation and technology; health, wellness, and beauty
- Select businesses will be invited to participate in a pitch competition during Hy-Vee's OpportUNITY Inclusive Business Summit on June 1, 2023, at Monona Terrace Community & Convention Center.
- The pitch competition will consist of short presentations with the respective business owner(s). Five businesses will be pre-selected to present their products or services in three pitch categories: or 15 businesses total.

- A panel of judges will select one grand prize winner to earn \$30,000. Plus, one business from each pitch category will be selected to win \$5,000. Additional cash investments will be awarded and select finalists may be invited to participate in a roundtable meeting following the summit.

- Minority- or woman-owned
- Midwest-based
- Operate primarily in Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, South Dakota and/or Wisconsin
- Offer economically viable and/or previously tested products or services in one of the following categories: food and beverage; product innovation and technology; health, wellness, and beauty.

- **Who is qualified to attend the summit?**

Hy-Vee invites minority- and women-owned businesses that are seeking professional learning, resources to grow their business and networking opportunities to attend the summit at no cost. Hy-Vee also invites local community organizations, area business groups and professionals that support small-business development.

In addition to watching a pitch competition, attendees will participate in an expo that offers resources for small businesses, learning opportunities through presentations and panel discussions, have the chance to be inspired by others and more.

- **How are winners chosen? / Does every business get the opportunity to participate in the pitching competition?**

Eligible businesses are encouraged to submit their products or services for showcase at Hy-Vee's OpportUNITY Inclusive Business Summit in Madison, WI on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. A panel of Hy-Vee judges will determine which applicants will participate in the pitch competition at the summit.

- **When will local business applicants be notified of their participation at the summit?**

Eligible businesses that apply to showcase their products or services at Hy-Vee's pitch competition will be notified by Hy-Vee's selection committee of their participation around May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.

- **What will winners receive?**

A panel of judges will select one grand prize winner to earn \$30,000. Plus, one business from each pitch category will be selected to win \$5,000. Additional cash investments will be awarded and select finalists may be invited to participate in a roundtable meeting following the summit.
